Masonic Care Community recently purchased a site in Henrietta, NY, south of Rochester, to further support the Masonic mission in New York state. The master plan includes a variety of housing options including single family homes with garages, and forward-thinking apartments that will support aging in place. A customized



community center, anchored by a memorial to the fallen soldiers for all divisions of the armed services, will be centrally located and easily accessible by residents and the public on the campus. Additionally, the campus is planned with multiple walking trails and is close to the Lehigh Valley Trail, a very popular community trail which provides social outdoor engagement.

The Masonic Care Community of New York sought an evaluation of their existing campus to add additional independent living units; implement alternative independent living products; and reposition existing structures to create new common amenities, support offices, and clinical evaluation spaces. approach to master planning yielded two primary objectives: the creation of a visual and physical community link to establish a more interconnected campus, and the expansion of spaces for social interaction and community engagement. SFCS recently completed the enhancement of MCCNY's wellness and dining programs, as well as the development of a new independent living cottage, garden, and villa-style homes.

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
